Request to opt out of Membership of Murray Edwards MCR

UNIVERSITY OF CAMBRIDGE EDUCATION ACT 1994

The Constitution of the Murray Edwards MCR sets out the procedure by which a student may opt out of Membership. This right may be exercised by any student who is a Member of the MCR.

The MCR will make its services available to students who choose formally not to be Members. Nevertheless, a student who opts out of Membership is not regarded as being represented by the union in relations with the College, nor is the student eligible to stand as a candidate or to vote in elections.

A person who resigns Membership, and who holds office in the union concerned, or Membership of a Committee or other body of the union, shall thereby vacate it.

Notice of a student's wish to opt out of Membership must be given on this form, which should be returned to:

A decision to opt out takes effect for the remainder of the academic year in question (i.e. to 30 September next following).
